Renshu means "practice"; this composition consists of practice exercises composed and choreographed by Tanaka Seiichi Sensei, who founded the San Francisco Taiko Dojo in 1968. Tanaka introduced kumi daiko (Japanese ensemble drumming) to the United States. These practice rhythms emphasize proper stance, various techniques for striking the drum and rim, and group coordination.
