




Percent of Population Living in Poverty in Hanover, 1990




Percent of Population Living in Poverty in Hanover, 2000




Percent of Population Living in Poverty in Hanover, 2010




Hanover Poverty Rate, 2014




White Population and Poverty, 2000




White Population and Hanover Poverty Rate, 2014




Black or Africa American Population and Poverty, 2000




Black Population and Hanover Poverty Rate, 2014




Asian Population and Poverty, 2000
