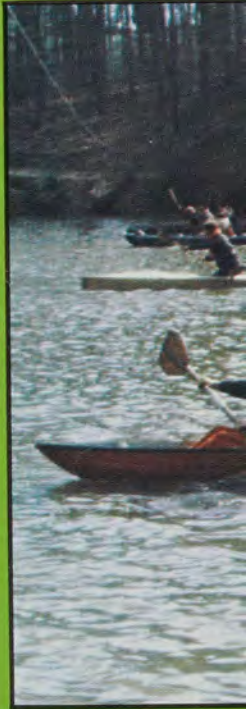

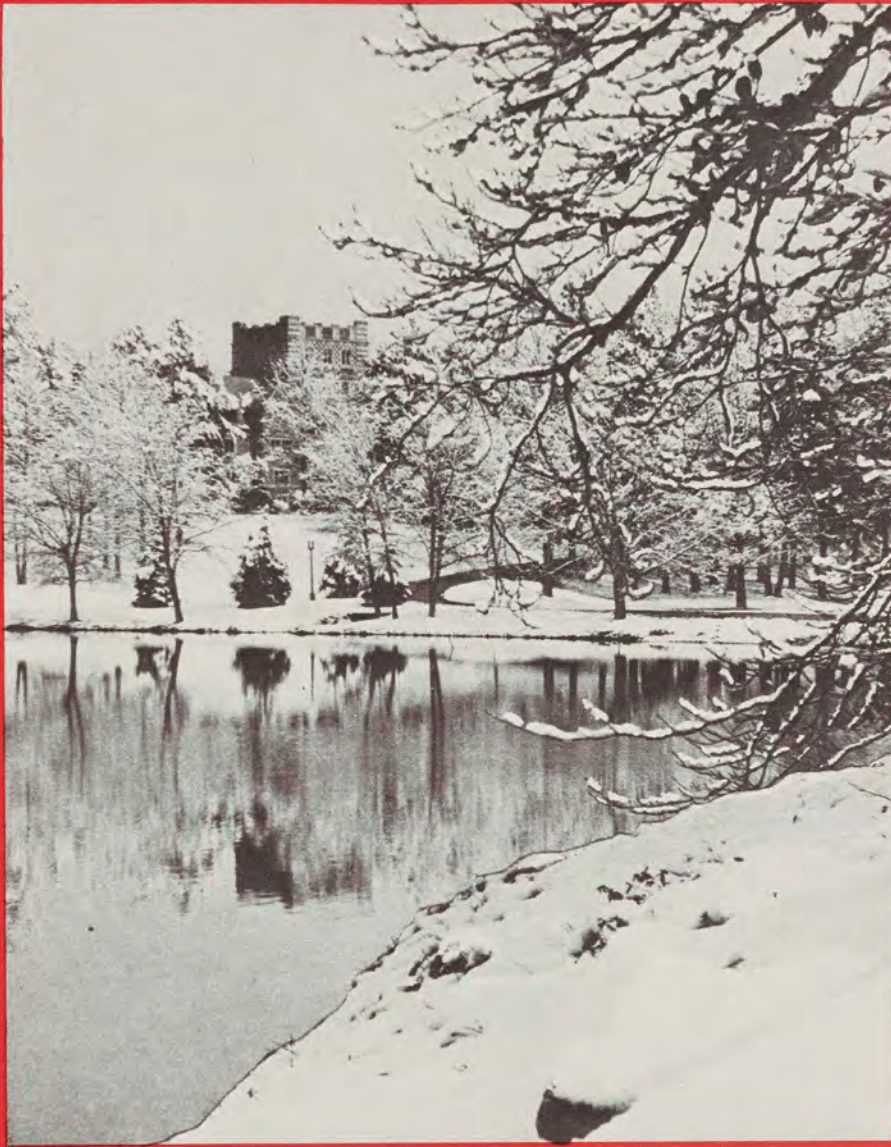




The five-second hero

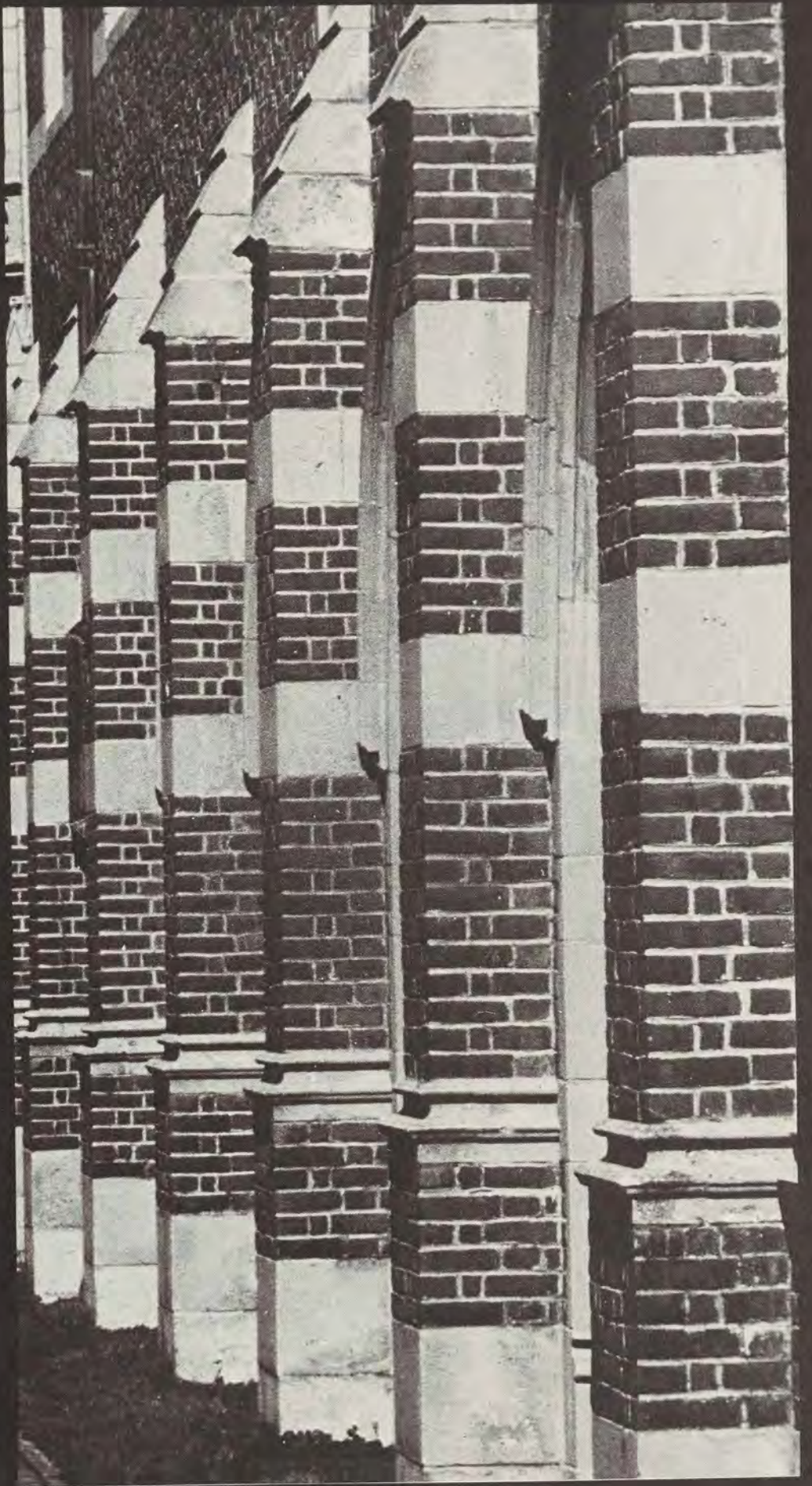


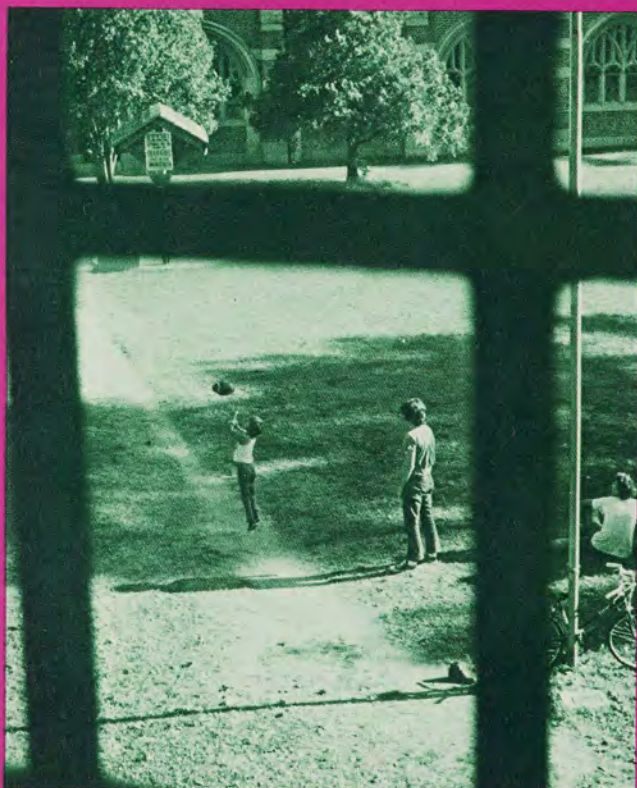

Probably the most important problem encountered at our age is redefining what we are. Rejecting the adolescent ideal of conformity for the search for uniqueness is an integral part of life...

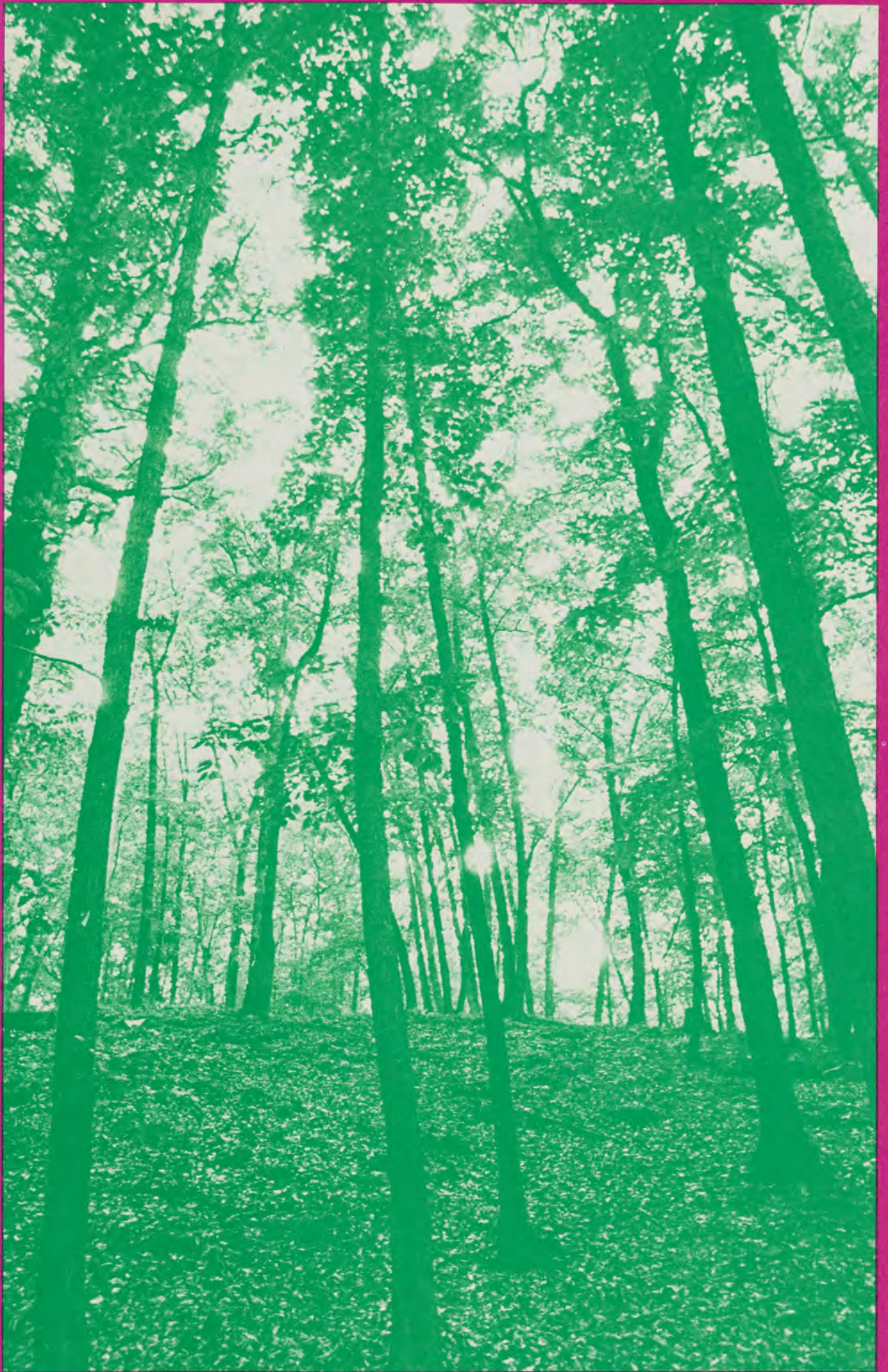


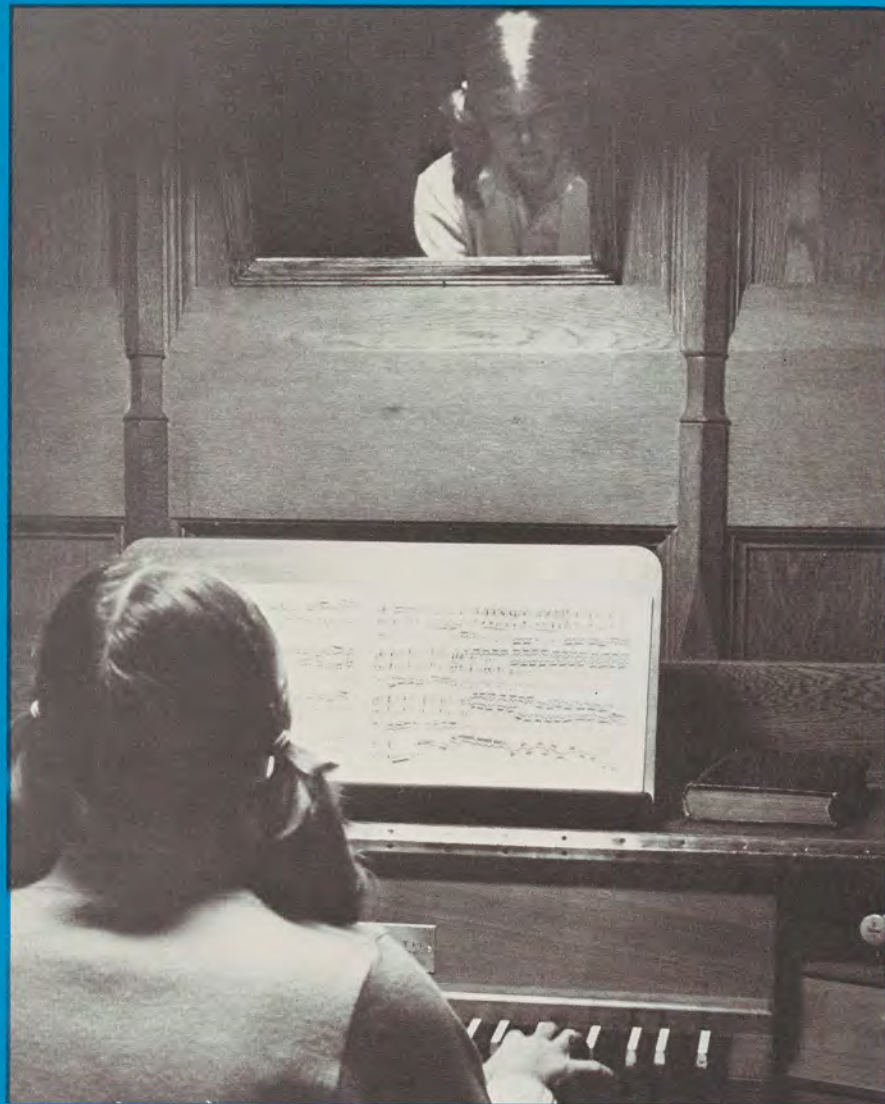

'73 was the year when records were broken honors were bestowed and "fans" followed the team to "sellout" games.

For the first time in our 92-year history of football the University of Richmond was voted into the long-coveted Associated Press Top Twenty poll.

In the first three games "Kelly's" heroes became known as the "O" gang, while the "Bruisin'" Barties mounted up their points, 42-0, 35-0, 42-0.

The peak of the season came when the Spiders beat West Virginia for the first time in 12 years and the second time in 17 meetings.

But the next week we lost to Northeast Louisiana down in the "Bayou" and a lot became memories. The Southern Conference title was still destined to be ours, but then on that cold, awful day in Greenville, N. C., we suffered a 44-14 defeat.

It seemed like a joyless end as the week before the

William and Mary game passed. But the season ended with a 31-0 victory over W & M, and the UR spirit was greater than ever against these rivals.

The UR became a "powerhouse" of football in Virginia. Loprete, Pearson, J. Amrhein, Moye, Smith, and Kelly were named to the All-Southern Conference Team and the Honorable Mention All-American Team. Smith was named to the Third Team All-American, and Kelly became the National Lineman of the Week after his performance in the WVA game. Kelly, Smith, and Pearson played in the Blue-Gray game; Smith also went to the annual East-West game; and Shelton played in the American bowl.

The season ended 8-2. It was a year for any college to be proud of. It ended with more people in the nation knowing we're here, and less saying, "University of Richmond? Where's that?"

With three games under their belts, the Spiders had yet to be scored upon by any team, while chalking up 118 points of their own. The UR defense was number one in the nation against the rush and in scoring.

In the opener against Davidson there was never a question of who would win. With a score of 42-0, the Wildcats were left trampled by Barty Smith's 109 yards of running and the super defense headed up by Vic Moye, senior defensive tackle.

The next week the Spiders stayed at home to host the VMI Keydets, and again the opposition couldn't score. The 35-0 victory included four touchdowns due to VMI fumbles. There were a record number of seven recovered opposition fumbles in all. Safety Bob Loprete fell on two fumbles, intercepted a pass and fell on a blocked punt. Linebackers Pat Kelly and Billy Mock also recovered two VMI fumbles each. Juniors Harry Knight and Dave Yount shared the quarter-backing duties, with Knight throwing two touchdown passes and Yount another.

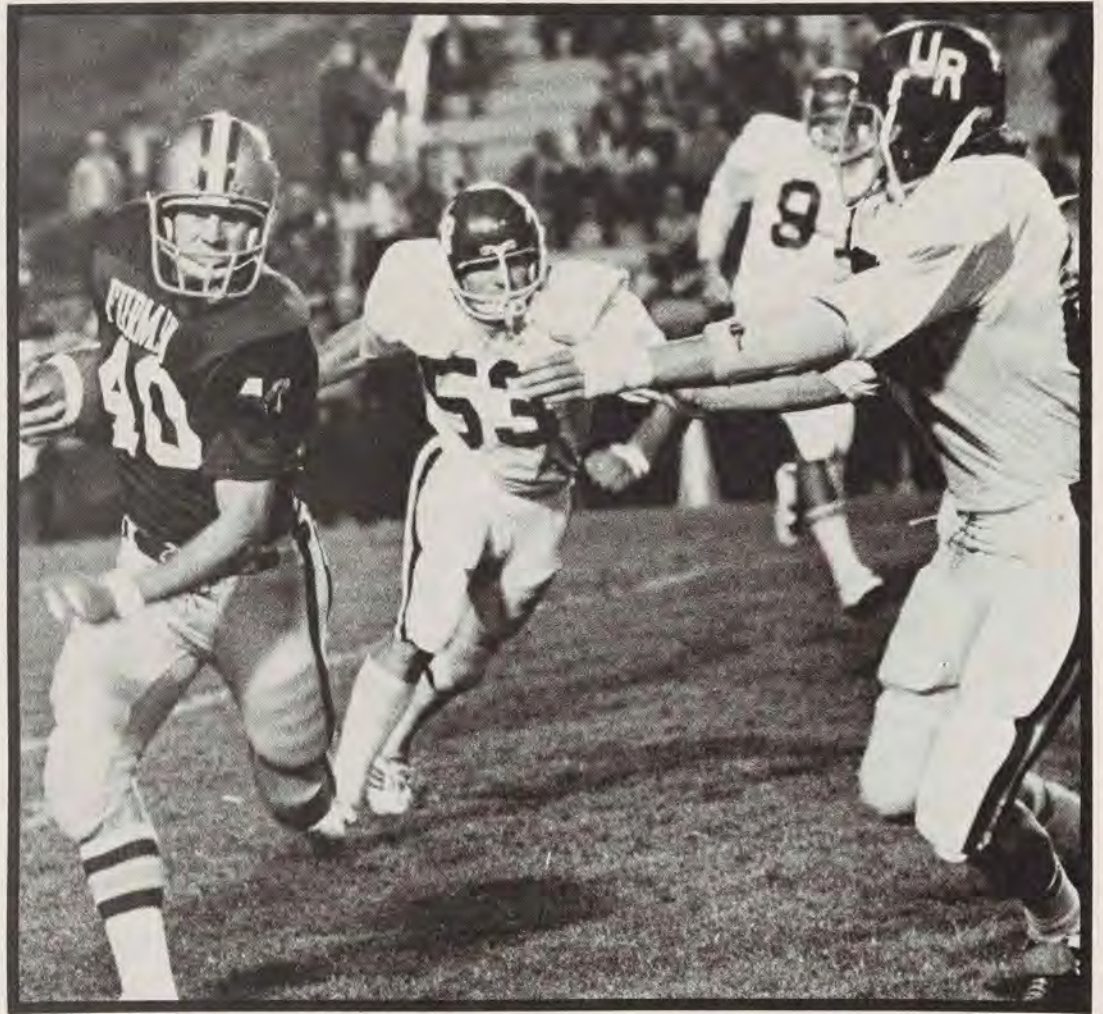


One more game brought one more win, and the Spiders crushed Wake Forest 41-0. The UR defense set up three of the four touchdowns in the second quarter, and as Frank Jones put it, "They got the ball for us and the offense pushed it in." He added, "I really don't think we have a problem with our offense. Seventy-seven points in the first two games and 41 today isn't bad." Bobby Allen rushed 111 yards in 19 carries. "Kelly's Heroes" as the defense was now called, was making Richmond history — but then so was the entire team.

Ace Owens saved the day — and the football game — for the Spiders when they defeated Furman, 20-17. With 3:49 remaining in the game, and Richmond trailing 17-13, Owens recovered a Furman fumble on their 18-yard line. Five plays later Bobby Allen gave Richmond its winning touchdown. The game meant an end to the Spider's three-game shut-out string, but it also meant four straight victories in the season, and a tie for the Southern Conference lead with East Carolina.

The margin was more comfortable in the 42-20 defeat the Spiders dealt Southern Mississippi in the Silver Anniversary Tobacco Festival game. As City Stadium's audience of 20,000 looked on, the Spiders tried to get some pass completions, which they weren't having much luck with for a good part of the game. But they kept trying, and Bobby Allen caught a 23-yard pass and went on to snatch a pass from two Southerners which was intended for Mike Mahoney. Harry Knight completed nine of 24 passes for 158 yard during the game as well as running for 16 yards.





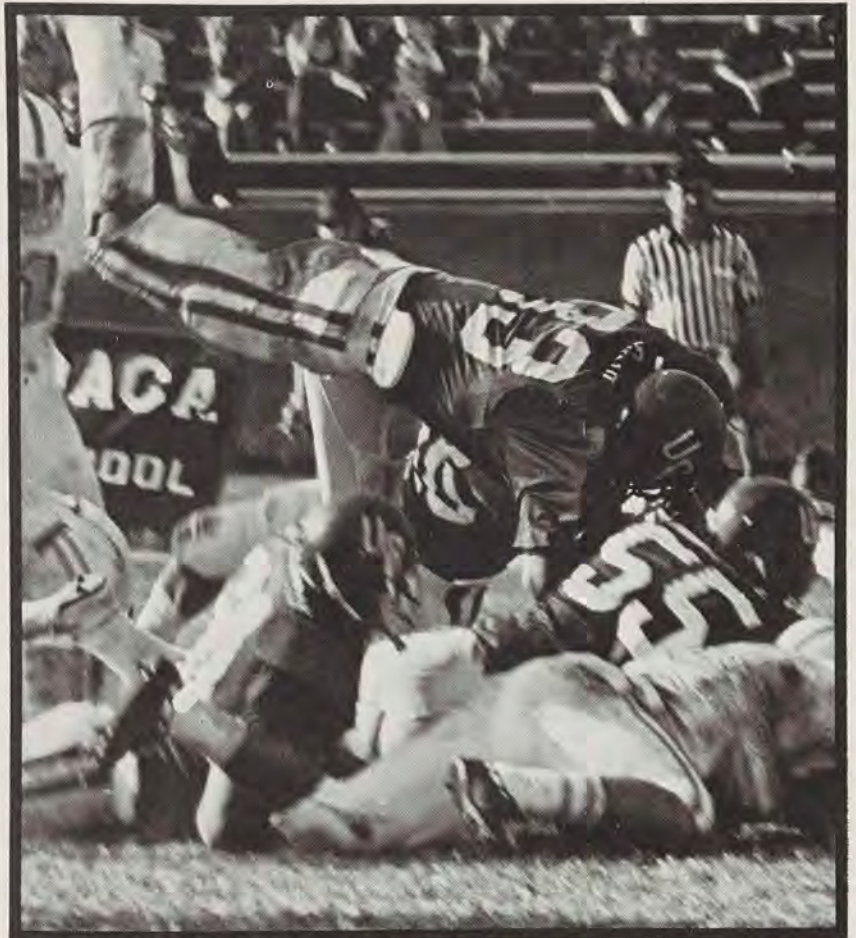
Richmond's win over West Virginia, was a game that made history. And it didn't take the record homecoming crowd of 21,172 long to realize it. It was Richmond's 10th straight win over two seasons, and sixth in a row this year. Best of all, it won for Richmond the rating of 20th in the nation in the Associated Press Top 20 poll. No other Spider team in history could claim such an honor. To add to such honors, Linebacker Pat Kelly was named National Lineman of the Week, Southern Conference Player of the Week, and State Player of the Week. Kelly's Heroes picked off six Mountaineer passes, a new school record, Kelly himself intercepted two passes and was in on 23 tackles — 11 individual tackles and 12 assists, and knocked down four other passes. The Homecoming game, and the news the following week of Richmond's 20th rating, gave Richmond fans a pride that they'd never known before.

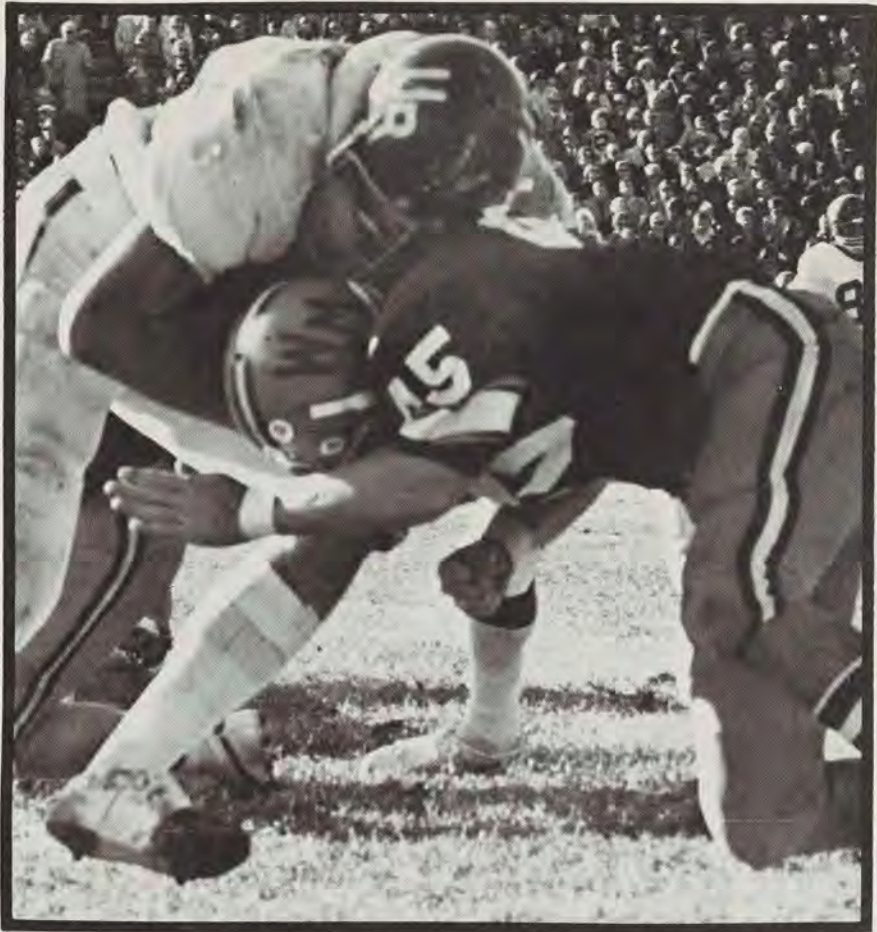

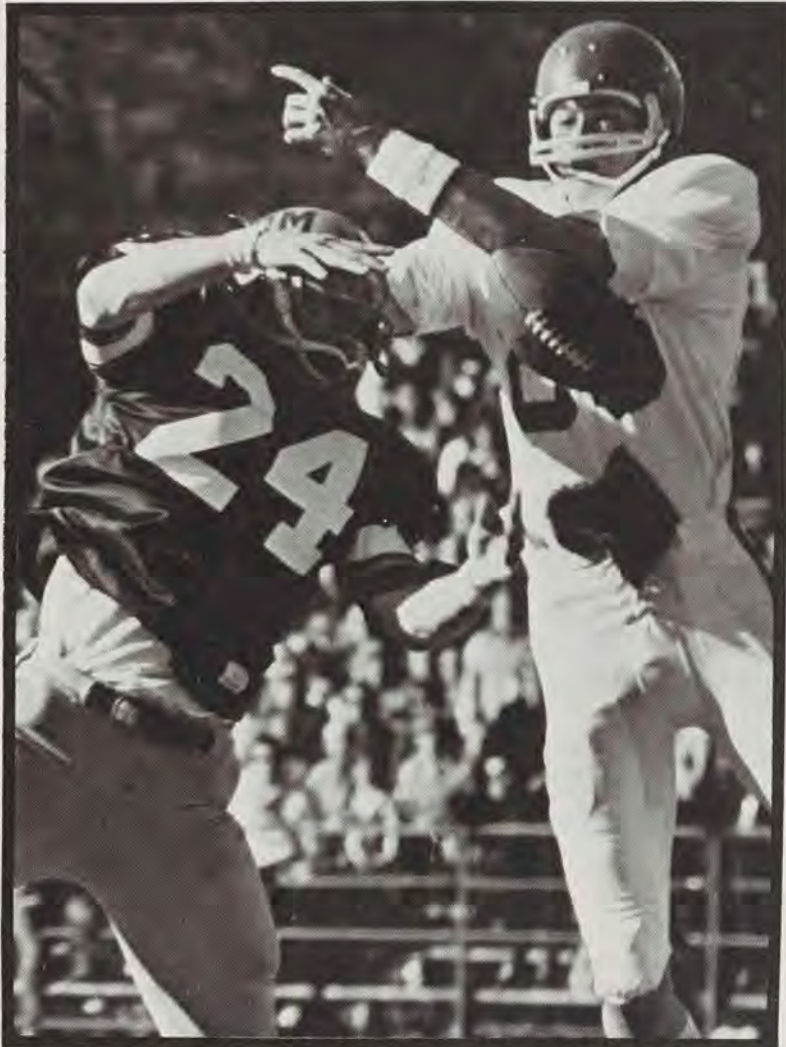
There was no joy among Richmond fans on Saturday night, October 27. The Spiders' record — 10 straight wins in two seasons and six straight wins this season — was over. It was enough to make even the toughest Richmond player wipe an imaginary speck of dust from his eye. The 14-8 catastrophe could very well have been a shut-out had not split end Mike Mahoney caught a deflected pass for five yards and scored with 50 seconds left to play. Speaking of the defeat, Coach Jones said, "Now we'll just have to get up off the floor."

The Spiders did just that as The Citadel found out when they were trampled 27-0. "Bruisin' Barty" rushed for 206 yards while breaking five individual school records. He made three touchdowns — totaling twelve for the season and one more than the former record of eleven set by Walker Gillette in 1969. His season record for touchdowns rushing — ten, broke Billy Meyers' mark for last year. Smith's 72 points in a season broke the record of 67 made in 1961 by Earl Stroudt. He also carried 420 times in his career, for 1,789 yards, again breaking Stroudt's marks of 400 carries for 1,767 yards.

The next game, against East Carolina University, was the decisive game determining who would be the Southern Conference champions — and the Spiders decisively lost, 44-14. After a minute and 16 seconds of play, ECU made their first touch down. Richmond fought back with a 70-yard drive, ending in a 35-yard pass from Harry Knight to Mike Mahoney. Barty Smith left the game in the third quarter with a pinched nerve, as did Pat Kelly. One bright spot for the Spiders in an otherwise cold and sunless day, was the performance of Al Newby. He returned the last five kick-offs for 131 yards, an average of 26.2 yards a carry.

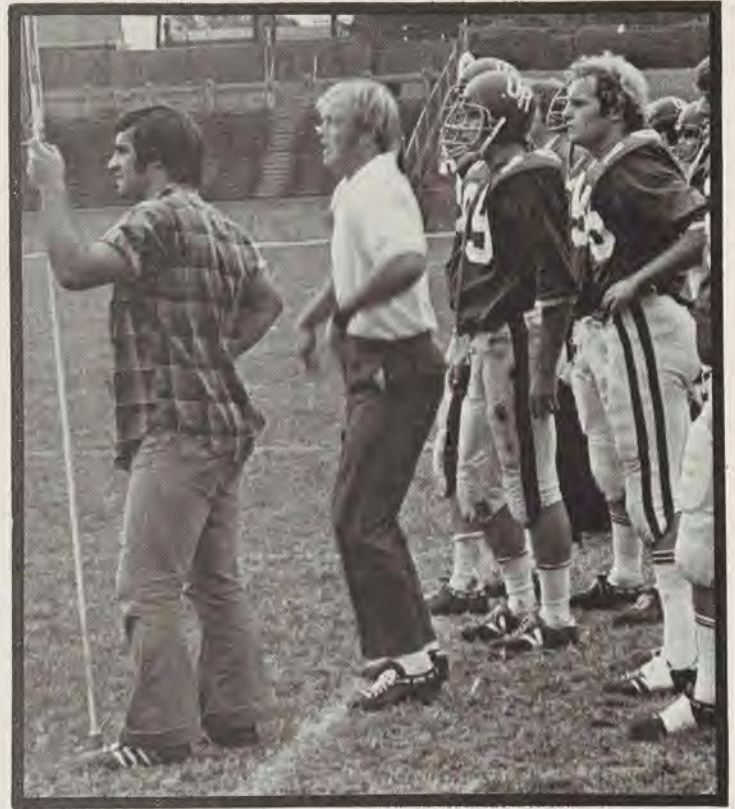


Richmond ended its football season in a big way - by stomping William and Mary 31-0. The overflow crowd estimated at 15,500 saw Barty Smith rush 25 times to 128 yards, to become the greatest single - season rusher in Spider history - 797 yards to replace Billy Meyers' 763 yards last year. He played despite the pinched nerve he had suffered previously, and sat out in the fourth quarter. Pat Kelly did not play, because of a pinched nerve, but his teammates on the "Zero Gang" earned their fifth shut-out in ten games. Offensively, the Spiders ran 87 plays and accumulated 461 yards. It was quite a day.

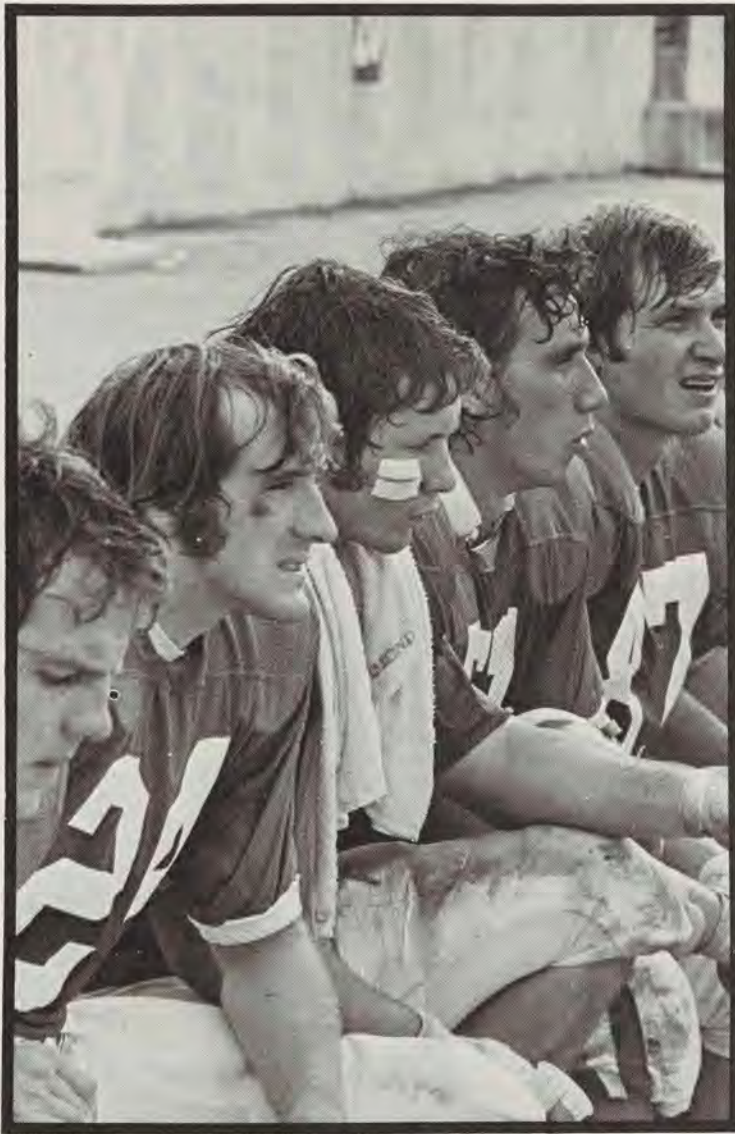

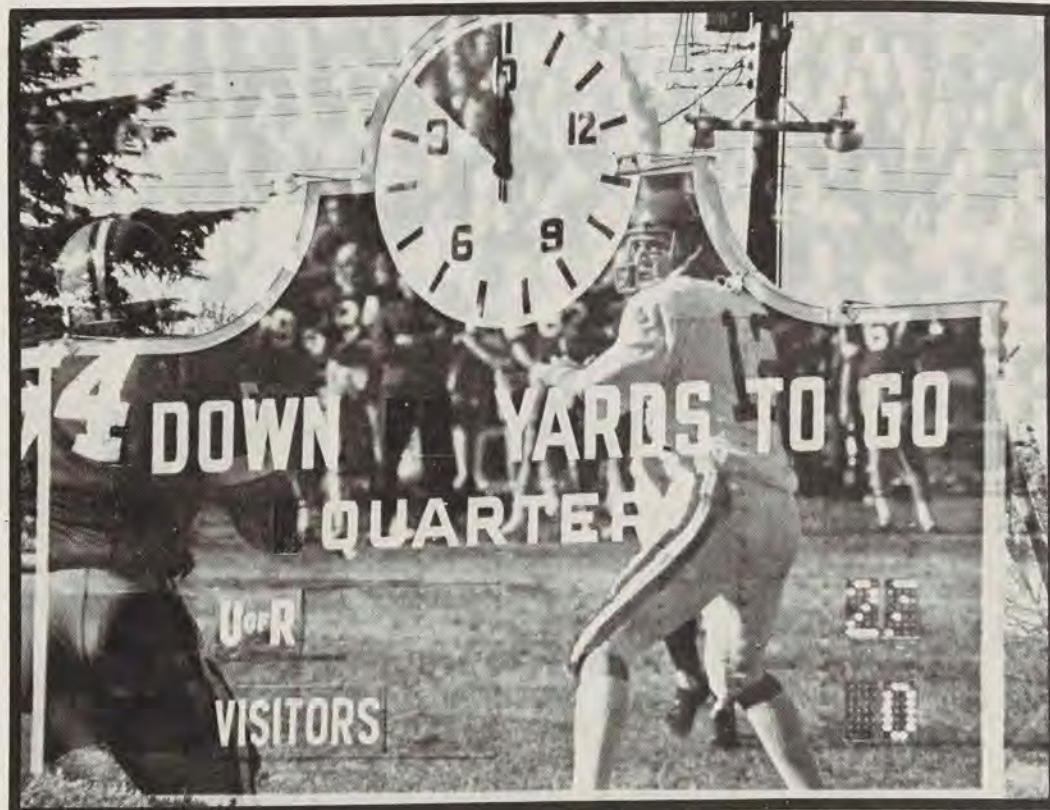

McCurdy, a transfer student from U.Va., was known mostly for his dedication and leadership ability. This was proved by his great accuracy in shooting and his long hours of practice.

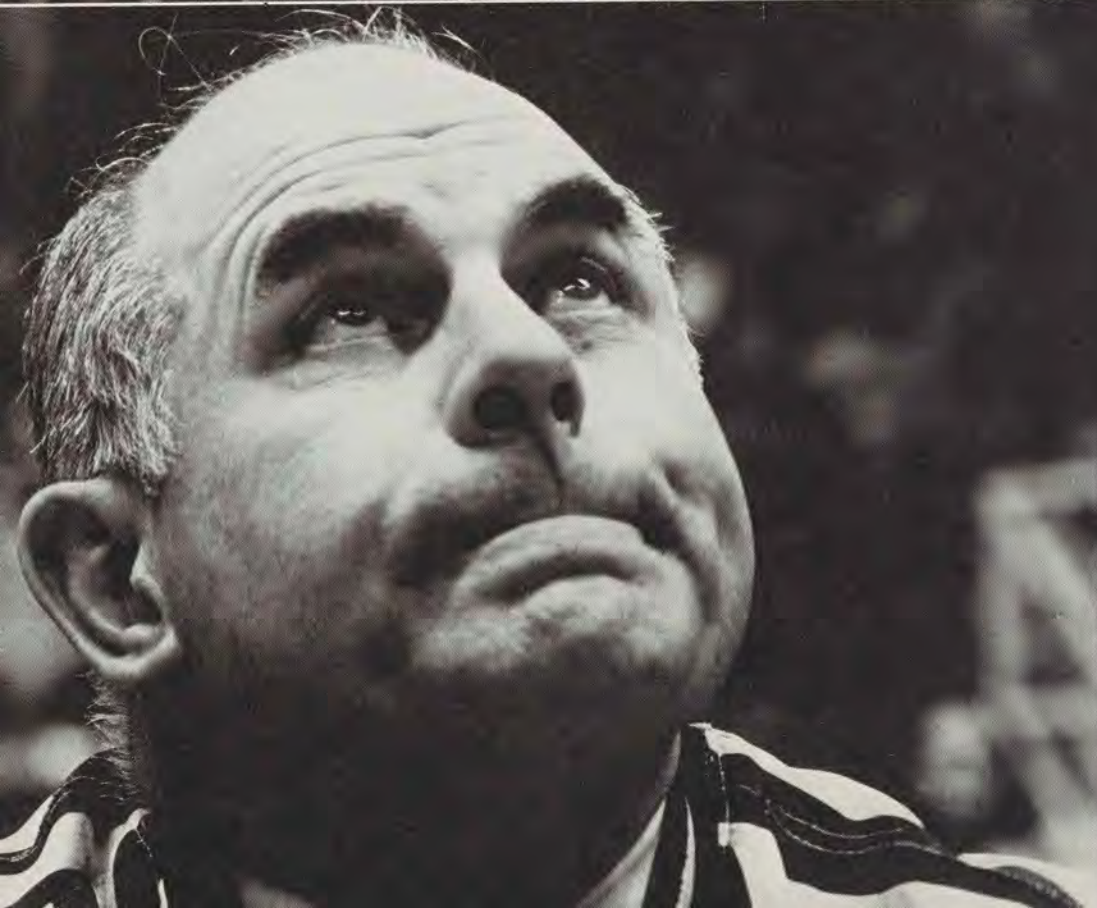
Gray, better known as Sly, had "tremendous jumping and timing ability," according to Coach Mills. Gray also supplied the team with much motivation due to his hustle.

Hard opponents like East Carolina were beaten; others would not bow so easily.

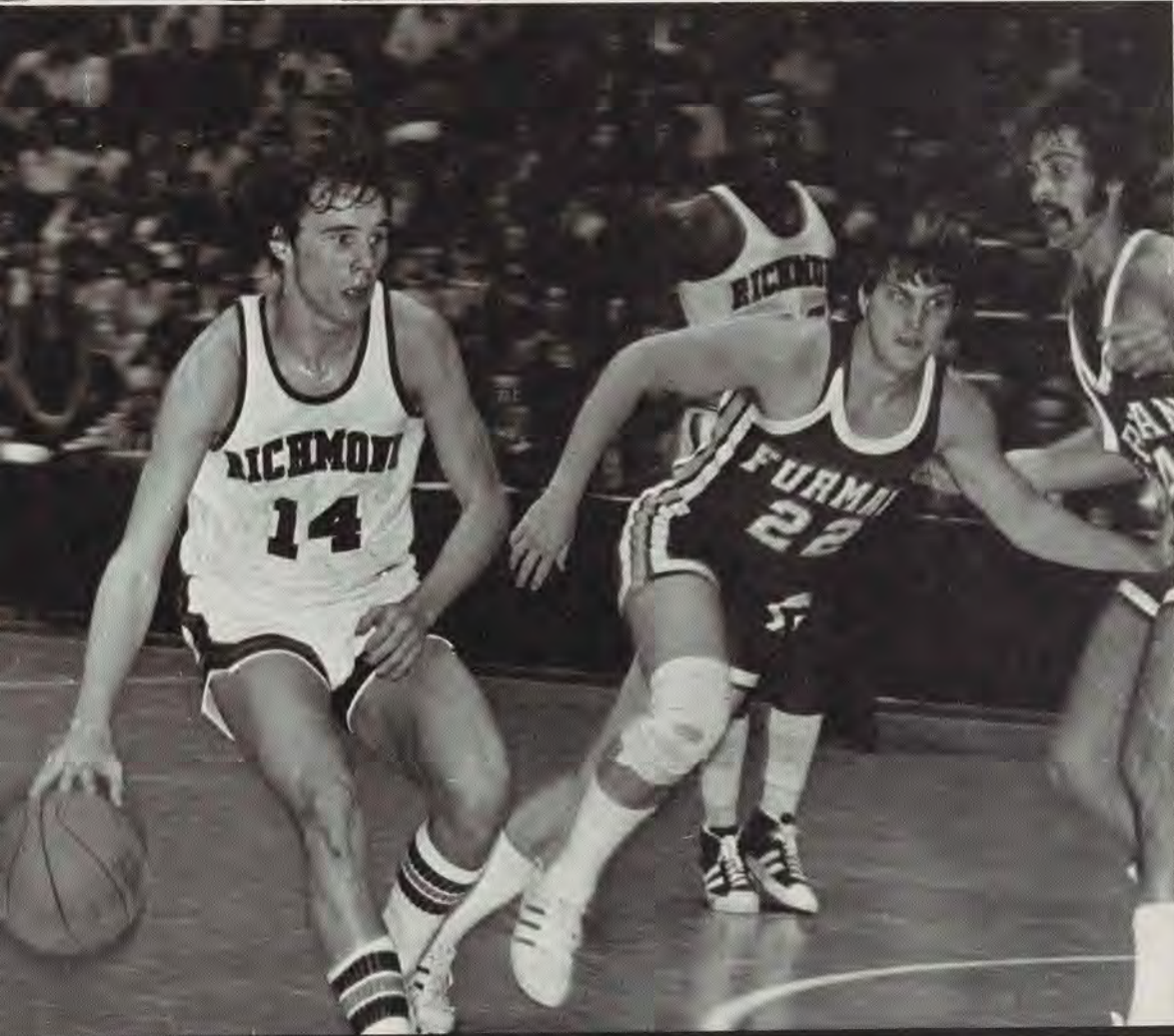

Other administrators, too, have found that serving this university is a lifetime undertaking that is never completed.





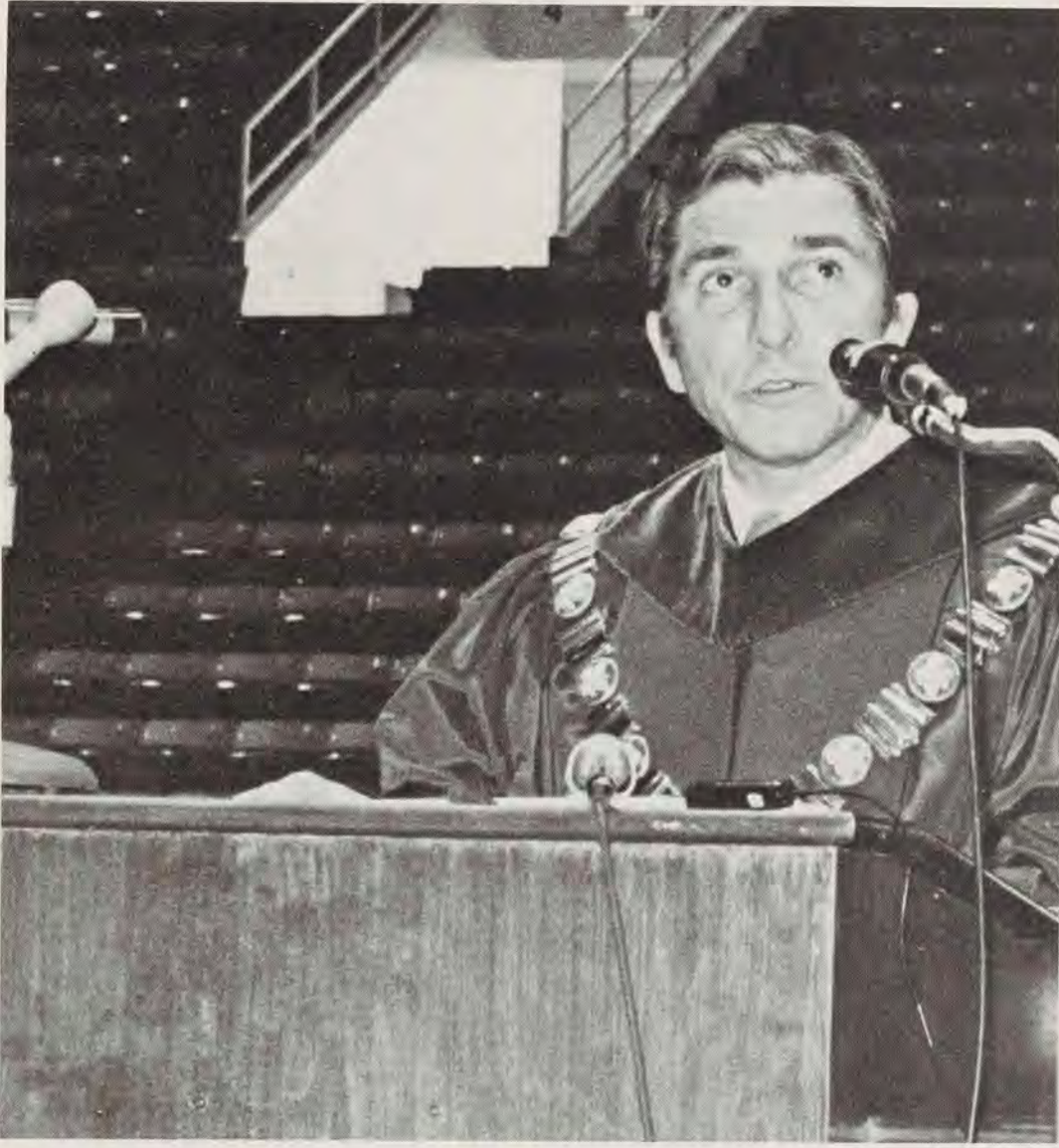
The U of R: The Richmond Community

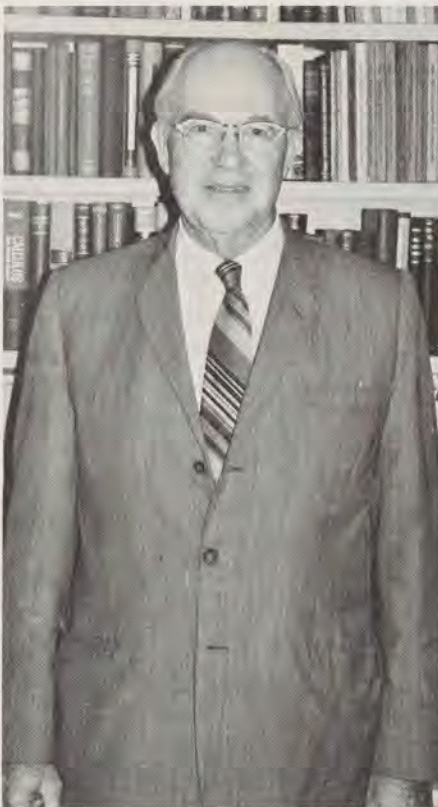
Q: What, in your opinion, does the "Our Time in History" program mean to the University? How is the incoming money affecting the University?

"We have a very solid, but conservative academic policy. With the physical plant we will have, I believe we can have one of the truly outstanding programs, one of the finest in the nation."

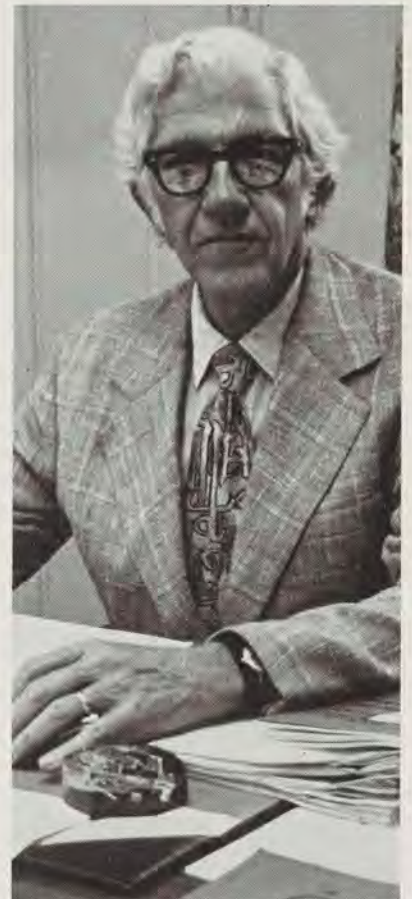

Although the campus police force is small, I feel that we are adequate to do the job that has to be accomplished at the University."

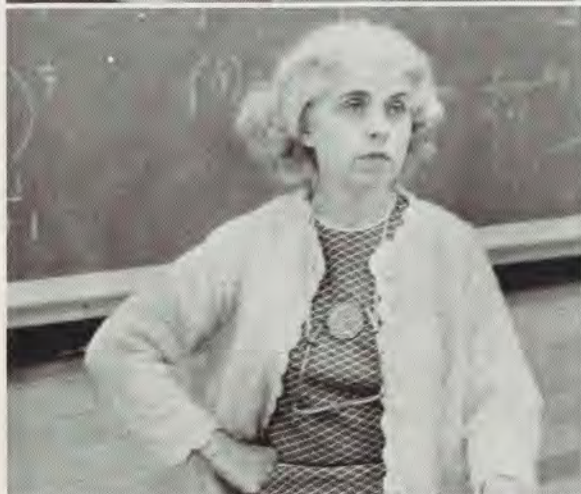

And the Future . . .



The presence of bulldozers, workmen in hardhats, and the sounds that accompany building or tearing down have been with the University community for several years. They are a reminder that the University of Richmond is changing, getting a face lift, and they serve as an external symbol of new values that go much deeper.



Changes for the future will be brought about because of the University's "Our Time in History" development program which has as its goal the raising of \$50 million in ten years. The program,

launched in March of 1972, is designed "to make this school the best small private university in the nation," according to President E. Bruce Heilman.



The T. C. Williams School of Law has received an addition. The \$750,000 M. M. Long Wing to the Law building has meant an increase in enrollment at the law school. The wing was dedicated in April of last year.



The biggest construction resulted in the Robins Center, which was dedicated in December, 1972. The \$10 million facility, housing an arena that seats approximately 10,000 people, a 25-yard, six lane swimming pool, seven official-size handball — raquet courts and a host of other facilities, serves as a source of pride for students, alumni and faculty.



The President's Home was completed in the Spring of 1973. The money was given to the University by an anonymous donor. This house provides the University with a center to entertain both the campus and the community, and it provides the president with a family home.



Renovation has helped convert two 60-year-old dormitories into more comfortable and much safer living facilities. Thomas Hall received \$400,000 worth of renovation last spring, which includes air-conditioning, new plumbing and wiring, and carpeting. North Court Dormitory at Westhampton also received air-conditioning, carpeting, and improved wiring and plumbing systems.



Outdoor sports have also received new facilities. Eight tennis courts were finished this fall, taking the place of the four courts facing east-west on the Richmond side of the campus. The new courts face north-south, and alleviate the problem of sun in the eyes. Construction on a \$175,000 all-weather Chevron track having eight, 48-inch lanes was also begun this fall.



A new dormitory, the Agnes Gray Dormitory, will house 250 women when finished. The \$1.8 million structure is scheduled for completion next fall.



One of the top priorities with which the money will be used is the expansion and renovation of Boatwright Memorial Library. A \$3.5 million University Center for social, recreational, governmental and academic services is also planned.

An \$8 million science complex to house the department of Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics and Psychology is planned to take the place of the 45-year-old science buildings now being used. Also, an administration complex to house the now scattered administration will be built at an estimated \$1.5 million. The major functions which will be grouped in the new facility are the President's offices and Board Room, financial and business services, University relations and admission offices.

The plans for the \$50 million development program are ambitious and far-reaching. Many will not be completed in time for the students now enrolled here to enjoy. But they show a change of attitude at the University. It is no longer a question of the University merely continuing to function, but of it progressing and improving. Such improvements will give those students who come to the University of Richmond in the future even more of which to be proud.
