Richard Becker, Associate Professor of Music at University of Richmond, has performed at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, The 92 Street Y, Library of Congress, the French Embassy, the National Gallery, and, in Paris, at Salle Michelet and Salle Cortot. His performances are described as “powerful” (*Washington Post*), “admirable in taste and technique” (*New York Times*), and “brilliant and elegant” (*Richmond Times-Dispatch*). His compositions are deemed “exciting [and] intense” (*Berkshire Eagle*), “clever and intriguing” (*Baltimore Evening Sun*) and “refined yet passionate” (*Newlin*). His poetry has appeared in such journals as *The Literary Review*, *America*, *Columbia*, *Baltimore Review*, *Cold Mountain Review*, and *ucityreview.com*.

Doris Wylee-Becker teaches piano at University of Richmond, Collegiate School, and privately at home. She has studied and performed at Aspen Music Festival, PianoSummer at New Paltz, and Chautauqua Music Festival. She holds degrees from University of Richmond and Peabody Conservatory, with additional studies at University of Maryland, College Park. She enjoys cooking, ballet, traveling, and spending time with her husband and their two girls – daughter Ilana and dog Muffin.

Pianist Ilana Becker, age 9, is in fourth grade. In addition to piano, she also does tennis and ballet. She enjoys art, reading, and playing with her little canine sister, Muffin, age 3. She feels fortunate to have been selected to perform in three 2018-19 Richmond Ballet productions: *Circus Polka*, *The Nutcracker*, and *Cinderella*.



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
