**Barry Hannigan** is a concert pianist who has performed in Europe and in every region of the United States and who is particularly known for his excellent performances of 20th-century music. He was recently honored as the recipient of a Solo Recitalist Grant from the National Endowment for the Arts. He has recorded for Opus One Records and for Radio Telefis Éirreann (National Public Radio) in Dublin, Ireland, and has appeared often on radio and television. A native of Denver, Hannigan received his D.M.A. from the Eastman School of Music. He has regularly written reviews for *M.L.A. Notes* and is the recipient of many awards and prizes, notably those from the Ford and Presser Foundations.
