In New York he has performed at Alice Tully Hall, Town Hall (1991), Carnegie Hall, and the 92nd Street Y. His Washington, D.C. performances at the National Gallery of Art and at the Library of Congress have been broadcast over the Voice of America and on many National Public Radio stations.

Zheng Wang began violin studies with his mother at age 10 and turned to the viola six years later. He was principal violist with the Nankung Opera until he entered the Shanghai Conservatory in 1981 as a student of Xi-Di Shen. Upon graduating from the Conservatory, he was appointed assistant professor of viola there. He received his master's degree from Northern Illinois University, where he studied with Richard Young. He has been a guest artist with the Juilliard String Quartet at the Library of Congress.
