Michael Davison currently teaches Jazz and Trumpet at the University of Richmond. He holds a Bachelor of Music degree from the Eastman School of Music and a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He has performed as a member of the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater faculty brass quintet. Rochester Philharmonic. Milwaukee Ballet, Wisconsin Symphony and Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra. In addition, he has performed with B. J. Thomas, Chuck Mangione, the Temptations, Gene Bertoncini, and with both the Canadian and Empire Brass Quintets. Dr. Davison has recorded three albums and is in the process of publishing a series of books on the transcriptions of trumpeter Randy Brecker. In April, Mike will be recording a classical compact disc of trumpet and organ literature for TOG Records, due to be released in August, and Late 4 Breakfast will be recording its third album in May. During the summer, Dr. Davison is on the trumpet faculty at the National Music Camp in Interlochen, Michigan. Mike is in great demand as both a classical and jazz performer in the Richmond community.
